1: CONFIRM YOUR REGISTRATION

Once you've registered, please take the time to confirm your registration: If you just registered this year, did you receive a registration card in the mail? Have you recently moved, changed your name, or not voted in the past? Contact your County Board of Elections or Registrar of Voters to check your registration status by phone, email or in person. Some states may also have online voter verification tools; visit vote411.org, and choose your state.
